

# CITY OF WINTERVILLE COMMITTEE / BOARD INFORMATION

## Planning & Zoning Commission

This commission reviews and approves building projects and ensures compliance with existing zoning ordinances and the comprehensive plan. Three year term; meets the first Monday of each month (first Wednesday if Monday is a holiday) at 5:30 pm. Additional time beyond meetings may involve review of the city codes and ordinances and site visits to review building projects. *You must be a resident of the City to serve on this commission.*

## Variance Hearing Board

This board is appointed to hear all variance appeals to projects denied by the Planning & Zoning Commission. Meetings held as necessary to hear appeals. *You must be a resident of the City to serve on this board.*

## Library Board

The Library Board, in consensus with the Athens Regional Library System Director, recommends reasonable rules and regulations for the operation of the Winterville Library. The Board sets local policies and practices when there is no Athens-Clarke or Regional Library System policy governing that area of service. Three year term; meets the second Monday of January, April, July, and October at the Winterville Branch Library at 7:00 p.m. *You must be a resident of the City to serve on this board.*

## Ethics Committee

This committee is tasked with addressing ethics complaints against city employees and elected officials. Meetings held as necessary to address complaints. *You must be a resident of the City to serve on this committee.*

## Historic Restoration Committee

This committee is integral in guiding the restoration of the old Winterville High School and Auditorium. Duties include providing leadership and vision for this site, along with fund raising and identification of grant resources. Anticipated meeting schedule is once a month.

## Historic Preservation Committee

This committee's focus will be to maintain and, where necessary revitalize the historic elements of Winterville. Projects of interest will include the Carter-Coile Doctor's Museum and a registry of historic homes in the city. Meeting schedule TBD.

## Public Safety Advisory Committee

A partnership between our police force and the community will enhance the safety and well-being of citizens. This committee will spearhead that collaboration and will serve as a liaison for communication. Meeting schedule TBD.

## Business Development Committee

This committee will focus on branding and marketing of Winterville as a small-business-friendly community. Meeting schedule TBD.
