Upcoming Changes to Property Tax Billing

The property tax bill you receive this year from the Athens-Clarke County Tax Commissioner will contain a line item for your City of Winterville taxes. You will not receive a separate bill from the City and will need to make just one payment to ACC for both your City and County taxes. This new tax billing method will save the City both time and money. The millage rate for the City of Winterville remains at 2.90

Signage other than yard-sale signs also require a permit.

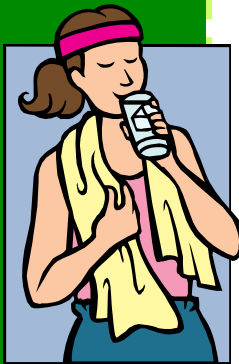

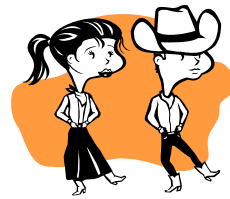


Zumba® Fitness
