## Help Keep our City Beautiful and Healthy

**Did you know** there are an estimated 74.8 million dogs in the United States, which create 72.5 billion pounds of dog waste per year.

**Did you know** just one gram of pet waste contains 23 million fecal coliform bacteria? These bacteria can cause serious gastrointestinal infections as well as infections to the ear, eye, and throat.

**Did you know** pet waste left on the ground contaminates our water supply?

**Did you know** as pet waste decomposes and runs into the stormwater system, it de-

mands a high level of oxygen from water? This demand can suffocate fish and plant life.

**Did you know** it is illegal to not pick up after your pet? The County ordinance prohibits allowing your pet to defecate or urinate on private property that is not your own. The County ordinance also requires pet owners immediately remove pet waste from public property.



Many pet owners are responsible and comply with the laws, but some do not. The City has installed three pet waste stations where pet owners can deposit bagged pet waste or even get a bag, should they find themselves in need of one. The pet waste stations are located near the Depot, at the Church Street entrance to Pittard Park, and near the Library. Please help keep our City beautiful and healthy by picking up after your pet.
