A new landing with wheelchair accessibility, refinished floors, and updated HVAC are all part of the renovations. Work to prepare for the renovations included inventorying and wrapping the artifacts in the space. Sam Alvarez and Lee Hartle spent many hours photographing, inventorying, and wrapping the medical instruments, books, and other artifacts in preparation for



the move. **Classic City Moving and Storage** is providing storage units free of charge to store the items while the renovations take place. A crew of volunteers will be moving the items to the storage units. What an amazing showcase of talent, volunteerism, and generosity from our great town!
