

Regular Meeting - Minutes

August 8, 2017

The Mayor and Council of the City of Winterville met at Winterville City Hall for the regular monthly meeting on Tuesday, August 8, 2017. Mayor Ferrelle called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.
